



Rape Prevention Education Assistant

Position Description

The Orange County Rape Crisis Center's mission is to stop sexual violence and its impact through support, education, and advocacy. We envision a just and equitable world free of sexual violence and all other forms of oppression. Our values include professionalism, excellence, accessibility, social justice, community involvement, self-care, and empowerment.

The **Rape Prevention Education Assistant** position is a part-time position requiring 10-15 hours per week from date of hire through June 1, 2020. It is classified as non-exempt, in accordance with the Fair Labor Standards Act. Will be paid on a contractual basis: \$15/hour, not to exceed 400 hours. Remote position with access to internet required.

Responsibilities:

1. Assist Rape Prevention Education Program Manager in adapting the OCRCC primary prevention education program to an online platform, including programs for teens, parents, and professionals.
2. Present virtual agency educational programs by request at schools and other settings in English.
3. Provide content-creation support to the OCRCC's teen-focused social media.
4. Assist Center's Rape Prevention Education Program Manager with administration of the Community Education Program, which includes tasks such as preparing monthly reports, record keeping, volunteer contacts, data entry, and preparation of materials.
5. Conduct follow-up and make referrals for individuals who raise concerns during Center's programs; this includes working with Community Education staff and school guidance counselors and/or the Department of Social Services when disclosures involve child abuse.
6. Assist with designing virtual outreach and educational materials.
7. Work as a team member in order to achieve the mission of the Center.
8. Complete all relevant trainings and other tasks as required.
9. Assist with in office program support tasks.
10. Maintain appropriate standards of confidentiality.

Qualifications Required:

1. Demonstrated effectiveness in public speaking and program presentation, including clear communication of complex concepts to children and adolescents.
2. Demonstration of cultural awareness, sensitivity, and competency.
3. Commitment to approaching rape prevention education from an anti-oppression framework.
4. Comfort working with and speaking of issues surrounding sexual violence.

Qualifications Preferred:

- Bilingual in English and Spanish.
- Previous completion of OCRCC volunteer training.
- Experience working with issues of sexual violence.
- Experience working with school-age children and/or adolescents.
