THERAPY + SUPPORT GROUPS

We offer short-term, trauma-focused therapy in English and Spanish. We also provide individualized advocacy, connecting you with a therapist who meets your needs.

Our support groups are led by trained facilitators and meet weekly for 8-10 sessions. They focus on building positive coping skills through discussion and educational group activities.

Therapy and support groups are free and confidential.

We offer educational programs in elementary, middle, and high schools as well as professional trainings and community presentations to spread awareness and empower our community through education.
